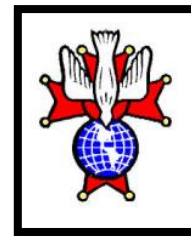

Veterans Day

On the 11th hour of the 11th day of the 11th month in 1918 the armistice that ended World War I was signed. In 1919 “Armistice Day” was established. In 1926 Congress passed a resolution and in 1938, Congress made it a national holiday.

President Dwight D. Eisenhower signed HR7786 on June 1, 1954, changing Armistice Day to Veterans Day.

Veterans Day is a federal holiday recognized each November to celebrate and honor all U.S. veterans – deceased or living. Veterans Day is not to be confused with Memorial Day, a day to remember those service members who gave the ultimate sacrifice of their lives. Memorial Day is in May of each year.

Some Things That Happen on Veterans Day

At exactly 11:00am, a wreath is placed on the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier.

Various locations have parades, picnics, bar-b-ques, concerts, etc.

If you hear Taps being played at 11am, chances are that it is being played by a member of Taps Across America of which there are members of this Assembly.

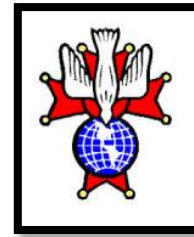

Bingo with the Vets

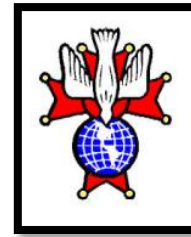
Bingo has been postponed until January in observance of the holidays. We will be going back on January 26th!!
